A VOLUNTEER ARTILLERY COMPANY IS COMMISSIONED

In good Faith and with understanding and true allegiance to Almighty God and The State of Arkansas, The Militia of Washington County Arkansas hereby gives proper Notice to all who may be concerned, that the Artillery Company, under the command of Wayne Fincher, with a full compliment of Arms is now Commissioned into its Table of Organization and Equipment, as ordained by The People, and recorded within the Preamble, Article One, Article Two and Article Eleven and other Articles of the Constitution of The State of Arkansas, of 1874 and the several applicable Articles of The Constitution for The united States of America and Public Record of October 19, 1998 in Book 3, Page 255/270, and Public Record of May 29, 2001, Misc. Personal Book 3-562 Washington County Circuit Clerk Office.

The Scope and Duties of the Artillery Commander;

The Commander shall be responsible for overseeing the personnel, equipment and operation at each Artillery Muster and,

1. The "Keeping and Bearing " of Artillery pieces.
2. Conduct and safety of Artillery personnel.
3. Authorized to appoint Officers under his Command.
4. Have responsibility and freedom of action to accomplish the objectives within the scope of his Command.
5. The Commander is authorized to handle any matters of Law concerning the Artillery Unit.
6. He shall be answerable to the Commander of The Militia of Washington County Arkansas and it's board of Officers.

I Wayne Fincher do solemnly affirm that I will support the Constitution for the united States of America and the Constitution of the State of Arkansas of 1874 and that I will faithfully discharge the duties of the Office upon which I am now about to enter.
