ORDER

The court has received a copy of Chief Judge Hendren's order of July 27, 2007, concerning appellant's in forma pauperis status. Appellant is directed to show cause, within ten days of the date of this order, why his in forma pauperis status on appeal should not be revoked and why the court's June 28, 2007 order appointing counsel under the provisions of the Criminal Justice Act should not be set aside.

Appellant and the United States are also directed to address that portion of Chief Judge Hendren's order asking that the case be immediately remanded for further sentencing proceedings, including vacatur of the sentence imposed in the case. The parties' responses on this issue are also due within ten days of the date of this order.
